

EPAs: are Entrustable Professional Activities - complex clinical tasks representative of an area of practice. Each covers several competencies. They are assessed by general observation and specific workplace-based assessments (WBAs), and are summative assessments. With the end-of-rotation "In-Training Assessment" (ITA) they comprise the two summative assessments carried out by supervisors. WBAs: are workplace-based assessments - specific, structured clinical tasks conducted under supervision and involving verbal and written feedback. They're formative assessments.
