Instructions to RANZCP Mock Examination Candidates for Paper II

- 1. At the appointed time, candidates are asked to turn over the question paper and are given 10 minutes to read the paper. During this time, no notes may be made either on spare paper or in the examination answer booklet.
- 2. After the 10 minutes reading time, a further three hours are allotted to answer the questions.
- 3. In this paper, all questions are to be attempted.
- 4. The paper is of 180 minutes duration and the total marks allocated are 180.
- 5. All Questions are answered in a separate answer booklet. You must use the pencil provided. An eraser is provided if you wish to change your answer.
- 6. You are strongly advised to use a ruler as you go down the pages of the answer booklet to ensure that you are entering each answer on the line of the correct question number.
- 7. A Stimulus handout is provided for reference when answering the CAP questions.
- 8. At the end of the examination time, candidates must stop writing immediately.
- 9. No examination booklets or working notes can be removed from the venue.
- 10. Before all examination papers are collected, candidates MUST ensure they have written their name on the front cover of the examination booklet <u>and</u> on the separate EMQ/CAP answer sheet.
